ACCESS

After the Barton Mills/Mildenhall roundabout continue on the A11 and take the turn off sign posted B1106 to Brandon/Elveden Centre Parks and Bury St Edmunds, at the top of the slip road turn left onto the B1106 towards Elveden and Bury St Edmunds.
